RECOMMENDATIONS



Continue focused effort of engaging medical staff and HA leaders in the Facility Engagement Initiative (FEI) and building facility-level relationships between medical staff associations (MSAs) and health authorities (HAs).

- Encourage MSAs and HA leaders to work on FEI activities that involve collaborative strategic planning
- Communicate the value and impact of FEI to current and potential new participants
- Encourage MSAs to incorporate equity, diversity, and inclusion principles into their MSA structure and FEI activities

FEI PROGRAM ACTIONS

SUPPORT AND FACILITATE OPPORTUNITIES FOR MSAS AND HEALTH AUTHORITIES TO:

- Tap into the knowledge and expertise of Engagement Partners and current and former MSA executives and health authority leaders for insights into building strategic connections.
- Build effective physician/MSA/health authority relationships and structures through administrator meetings and communications channels that connect peers to engage in collective advocacy.
- Use FEI program resources such as the Governance Guide and Engagement Toolkit (forthcoming) to support engagement processes between MSAs and with HAs.
- \checkmark Use practical guidance from the HR Toolkit to augment a strong MSA governance structure.
- ✓ Get updated provincial information and templates that can be used to communicate the impact of the FEI at MSA events/AGMs and among health authority leaders, and to incorporate into local orientation.
- Access practical Doctors of BC resources and guidance to integrate equity, diversity, and inclusion into FEI activities (e.g. roadmap).
- Engage in collaborative strategic planning during annual site review process.



Identify opportunities to encourage regional MSA and HA engagement activities.

- Encourage MSA executives and regional HA leaders to identify and discuss possible regional activities using FEI funding, particularly through sharing regional best practices and lessons learned
- Support collaboration between MSAs and HAs through regional knowledge sharing platforms and sessions.

SUPPORT AND FACILITATE OPPORTUNITIES FOR MSAS AND HEALTH AUTHORITIES TO:

- ✓ Work together on shared local priorities that also have strategic regional value, for broader impact and potential spread.
- Participate in regional roundtable sessions and peer to peer knowledge sharing events to build relationships across MSAs, and learn and share between sites and regions.
- Where applicable, join regional tables and committees to work on regional priorities and needs with other MSAs, and explore opportunities to align with or influence provincial work.
- Access best practices and lessons learned on local and regional engagement to inform relationship building and collaboration at the regional level.
- Learn from the experiences of other MSAs and health authorities to support regional collaboration, through increased provincial knowledge sharing supports (e.g. webinars, tools, success stories, etc.).
- ✓ Optimize participation in regional tables with insights gained from a review/evaluation of the impact of regional tables, conducted by the provincial FEI program (in development).



Create a strong data collection strategy to better track and communicate the impacts of the FEI.

 Conduct targeted consultations with key stakeholders involved in data collection

OPTIMIZE / UPDATE FEI PROGRAM PROCESSES:

- Review the current state of FEI data to determine if the data being collected are relevant and meaningful and shared with MSAs and HAs effectively.
- Conduct targeted consultations with MSAs and HAs to better understand data needs and required FEI support.
