

## KEY HIGHLIGHTS: SSC FACILITY ENGAGEMENT WORKING GROUP (SSC FEWG): March 12, 2020

### SUMMARY OF KEY DISCUSSIONS

### MSA BUDGET SUPPORTS UPDATE *Update and discussion*

Gary Coblenz – the new Manager for the Facility Engagement Provincial Team – along with Cindy Myles updated the SSC FEWG about tools and processes that are in development to support MSAs in their budgeting work including:

- a checklist for sites about what to expect and look for in a financial administrator
- a list of recommended financial administrators for incorporated sites to choose from, should they wish to make a change
- ensuring that all unincorporated sites are receiving the same level of service (from Enkel)

### MEETING TOPICS AND DISCUSSIONS

#### FACILITY ENGAGEMENT 2020/21 WORK PLAN AND BUDGET UPDATE *Review and decision*

An increase in FE's Doctors of BC administration fee and an additional provision of FE regional funds for health authority regions have necessitated a \$250,000 increase to the FE 2020/21 work plan budget approved in December 2019, for a new total of \$20.9 million. The SSC FEWG approved the change and noted that it would like to discuss site administration costs further at a future meeting.

#### SITE REPORTING AND REVIEW PROCESS FOR 2019/20 *Update and discussion*

The SSC FEWG was updated about the SRRP panels scheduled for April 14 through May 4 via Zoom (*note: cancelled post-meeting due to COVID-19.*)

The group discussed the integral role of Facility Engagement Liaisons (FELs) in the recommendation phase of SRRP to ensure more fulsome feedback for each site.

#### REGIONAL COLLABORATIVE COUNCIL: *Update*

SSC Liaison Laura Anderson updated the SSC FEWG about SSC's approval process for regional collaborative council – which are joint tables between physicians and health authorities to coordinate SSC and HA support for shared priorities – including a readiness checklist and broad goals.

#### SITES SEEKING FULL FACILITY ENGAGEMENT FUNDING: *Review and discussion*

The SSC FEWG heard funding presentations from several sites, their health authority partners and FELs, resulting in the SSC FE WG granting full funding to six sites:

- West Coast General Hospital, Port Alberni
- 100 Mile House District General Hospital
- G.R. Baker Memorial Hospital, Quesnel
- McBride and District Hospital
- Lakes District Hospital and Health Centre, Burns Lake
- Hillside Psychiatric Centre with Royal Inland Hospital, Kamloops
